<sup>4</sup> Pouched lamprey (*Geotria australis*) is listed by the [Department of Biodiversity Conservation and Attractions](#) as priority 3, poorly known species.

# This species may occur in the subcatchment as has been recorded in both upstream and downstream subcatchments and is known to undertake localised migrations between subcatchments.

\* Pouched lamprey have been reported elsewhere in the river system. This species migrates from the ocean to nursery habitats in some headwater streams.
